



WALK TO FEED THE HUNGRY

26th May 2018

Information Sheet

We will depart promptly at 10:30am from The Square in Petersfield (See map for location) It will take about 2-2½ hrs to walk from The Square, Petersfield to the Visitor Centre, Queen Elizabeth Park. Depending on how fast we walk we may have to stop (either in Buriton or somewhere in the Park) to let the Monks eat their lunch as they have to be finished by 1pm. Feel free to eat with them or wait until we reach the Park. We will officially stop at the visitor centre at Queen Elizabeth Park for lunch before returning to Petersfield back the way we came.

Parking

- Parking is available in Petersfield but as this will be a Saturday then please allow plenty of time to park as they can be busy. Car parks are marked on the map and will cost around £2.00-£6.20 depending on the distance from the town centre. If you are just being dropped off then Waitrose has a car park (3 hours max stay).

Toilets

- Petersfield : Public toilet facilities are located next to Waitrose which is a couple of minutes walk from The Square. (See map for exact location)
- Queen Elizabeth Park: Toilet facilities are available at the Visitor Centre

Food and Drink

- Please bring your own drinks, snacks, and lunch. There is a Café at the park but it's small.
- Please note that it is likely that you will have to sit on the ground to eat as seating is limited.

Other notes

- Please wear appropriate clothing i.e. walking shoes, waterproofs, sun hat/screen.
- We will be crossing fields and following footpaths.
- Please also note that there are sheep and cows in some of these fields. They may follow you but just keep together in a small group and quietly and calmly cross the field.
- Dogs are welcome but MUST be leashed.
- Please take all your rubbish with you.
- Please let one of the coordinators know if you are leaving the walk part-way though.
